Digital Age Comes to Amateur Radio Publications

Many of the Amateur Radio publication are now being offered in digital format.

CQ, World Radio, and QST are the 3 that I subscribe to. CQ charges \$27.00 for the digital edition (\$17.00 if you already subscribe to the printed edition) and \$38.95 (they do run specials for less) for the printed edition. World Radio is only offered in the digital format for \$19.95.

QST offers the digital edition free if you are a ARRL member.. You can bet that this will change down the road. When the President of the ARRL was asked about members being charged for the digital edition she stated "We have no plans "AT THIS TIME" to charge for the digital edition." Talk about leaving the door open for down the road.

CQ magazine uses a 3rd party (Zinio Reader) to distribute their digital magazines.

Last month I received a notice from Zinio that my digital subscription to World Radio and CQ was about to run out. Zinio said the renewal cost for CQ would be \$27.00. At this time I emailed CQ asking why the increase over what was on CQ's website. After a few days I received an email from CQ saying they were checking in to the situation. A few days later I received an email saying to go to CQ's website and renew from there. Several days later I received the following email from CQ. I believe this email was sent to subscribers.

Log in to your account at Zinio.com and click on "Account Settings" to view your personal settings. Opt out of Zinio's continuous service at any time and order directly through CQ to take advantage of our special prices!

Be sure to view the "digital edition combo rates" at the very bottom of this page - 1, 2 or 3 year subscriptions to all four of our magazines - you won't believe the savings!! Remember, our special rates are always just a click away at the CQ Online Store at <http://store.cq-amateur-radio.com>.

I checked my profile and sure enough it was set to automatically renew thru Zinio., which I changed to no automatic renewal. Another thing I have noticed is that many articles instruct you to go to the digital edition or the online edition to see the full article or for more information . This is going to become more prevalent. Personally I like the printed better. Easier to read in my "private office" and no problem laying the magazine on the beach chair and walking away. Try that with an E-reader. Also much easier to read than on an E-reader. I own a NOOK which is great for books but I find magazines hard to read. Like trying to look at the internet on an i-phone.

Just my 2 cents.
